

## Tools for the efficient allocation of the EU funds

### Description

This Workshop by Clean Air Action Group and CEEweb for Biodiversity aims to raise awareness to the importance of efficient allocation of European funds (RRF and MFF) and shares the insides of their project “Towards climate neutral EU: efficient allocation of the international funds”.

Through the workshop, participants will learn why the Partnership Agreement and the National Recovery and Resilience Plan are critical to the transition to a climate-neutral EU and what tools are available to influence decision-makers and relevant stakeholders.

### Background

Last year the European Green Deal was announced, the main goal of which is the transition of Europe towards climate neutrality by 2050. It will require a major change in public funding and incentives, hence huge funds (€672.5 billion of grants and loans) were allocated for the Member States to support easier transition and boost climate action. These funds represent a formidable opportunity for civil society to push towards a greener budget by changing the way the EU funds are used. It is time to act and act appropriately. Thus, it is crucial to understand how to influence the implementation of EU funds and deliver target messages to the relevant institutions.

As experts in the field, CAAG and CEEweb would like to convey how to make the spending of these funds more effective, increase transparency and support implementation, monitoring and assessment.
